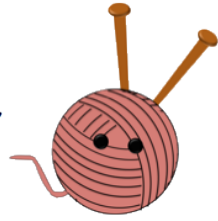


A Little Bit to Knit



Crochet Abbreviations

For crochet patterns by Sarah Gomez

All other abbreviations are explained in patterns

CC= contrasting color

Ch(s)= chain(s)

Dc= double crochet

Dc2tog= double crochet 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

Hdc= half-double crochet

Hdc2tog= half-double crochet 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

Magic ring= a technique for starting out working in the round. See this tutorial for details: <http://www.planetjune.com/blog/tutorials/magic-ring-right-handed/>

MC= main color

Nxt= next

Rnd(s)= round(s)

Sc= single crochet

Sc2tog= single crochet 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

Skp= skip

Slp st= slip stitch

St(s)= stitch(es)

Tc= triple (or treble) crochet

Tc2tog= triple (or treble) crochet 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

Yo= yarn over hook
