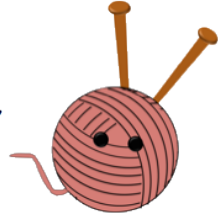


A Little Bit to Knit



Knitting Abbreviations

For knitting patterns by Sarah Gomez

All other abbreviations are explained in patterns

BO= bind off

CC= contrasting color

CO= cast on

dpn(s)= double-pointed needle(s)

k= knit

k2tog= knit 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

kfb= knit into front and back of stitch (1 stitch increased)

m1L= make 1 left- insert left needle into front of strand between stitches, and knit through back of strand (1 stitch increased)

m1R= make 1 right- insert left needle into back of strand between stitches, and knit strand (1 stitch increased)

MC= main color

p= purl

p2tog= purl 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

rnd(s)= round(s)

ssk= slip 2 stitches knit-wise, insert left needle into front of stitches and knit them together (1 stitch decreased)

st(s)= stitch(es)

yo= yarn over (1 stitch increased)
